Interim Adoption of the State of Michigan Court Rules
for Practice and Procedure Before the Tribal Courts

Section 1. Purpose & Findings

- A. On February 26, 2008 due to the recent establishment of the Tribal Court and its infancy, the Chief Judge adopted an administrative order to provide some form of established rules of practice and procedure for the Tribal courts until there was sufficient time to adopt comprehensive Tribal rules of practice and procedure.
- B. On July 29, 2009 the Chief Judge adopted Chapter 7 of Court Rules, *Rules of Evidence*, which has superseded the application of the Michigan Rules of Evidence.
- C. On September 2, 2009 the Chief Judge adopted Chapter 6 of Court Rules, *Rules for Small Claims*, which has superseded the application of Michigan Rules of Court.
- D. On November 4, 2010 the Chief Judge adopted Chapter 9 of Court Rules, *Rules of Appellate Procedure*, which has superseded the application of Michigan Rules of Court.

Section 2. Order

As the Chief Judge continues to adopt Tribal rules of practice and procedure, those rules will automatically replace the respective State of Michigan rules which otherwise remain in effect.
