Note: To calculate the adjusted income limit for families with more than eight members, add 8% of the four-person base to the eight-person income limit for each additional person.

*Example.* Nine-person *LIL* limit equals \$72,100; viz. 67,980 + (51,500 x .08).

\* Acronyms designate as follows: *LIL*—'Low-Income Level'; *VLIL*—'Very Low-Income Level'; *ELIL*—'Extremely Low-Income Level'.
